Mayor Mavrakis, "before I open the floor for Public Comment, this administration will not limit you to three minutes unless you are being repetitive and then we may ask you to cut it short. Feel free to come up and express yourself and we will give you as much time as you need, like I said, without being repetitious".

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mayor Mavrakis, "go ahead, Wayne. I am going to tell you something, I have gone to several Council Meetings and I never knew you had a voice. All of a sudden you take the floor, you take the mike, you take over the whole show. Go ahead".

Wayne Vlasic, "these are two announcements for the media and not only for the citizens of Monessen, but the entire Valley. Actually, the lower Westmoreland County I should say. The Westmoreland County Veteran's Affairs Mon Valley Office is now open at the Area Agency on Aging Office at 100 7th Street. It is open every third Wednesday of the month from 8:30 to 4:00. They would like you to schedule an appointment, although you can walk in. Once again, the VA Office which is in Westmoreland County has a satellite office at 100 7th Street, which is the Area Agency on Aging Building".

One thing that I would like to clarify from Monday night, this is in regards to the Adult Probation Alcohol Safety School, all it was Monday night was information that I passed along to Mayor and Council. I was instructed by the Mayor to get the information and bring it to the Work Session. There was a little bit of misconstrue in some of the words in the paper, but we are not guaranteed this course, we have to submit a proposal, if you will, and it is up to the Director of Adult Probation of Westmoreland County to award this site. There are going to be two sites, one at the southern end and one in the northern end. The southern end is what we are hoping to get here in Monessen. It is only 3-4 times a year, either 4 consecutive weekday evenings or 2 weekends, Saturday and Sunday. I just wanted to clarify that."

Mayor Mavrakis, "I want to thank you, Wayne".

Mayor Mavrakis, "before we adjourn, I would like to express my thanks to Holly. She has been real good with us, leading us through for the last week. You have done a good job, Holly and we appreciate it. You know we will have a good working relationship and everybody in City Hall has been real good with us. Naturally, our Council, we have been working together. We had a few differences, but we ironed them out and closed the door. We slapped around a little bit and we....."

Lt. Sue, "you know me, I am Lt. Sue from the Salvation Army. First and foremost, I wanted to thank people around this table that were such a great help when our building flooded at the end of December. The community support was outstanding. We were able to help meet need and be able to help an additional 100 families with Christmas gifts that we would not have been able to otherwise. We would like to thank the Police Department, both Fire Departments for coming to our aid and helping assemble toys and distribute them and get them out to the public. The Police Department was fantastic with helping with some security issues we had. So, we are very grateful to the City for the coming together and working together in a time of crisis.

But, that is over and we are moving forward. So, we are now thinking that we would really like to honor Albert Lexie and have an Albert Lexie Day and we are looking at Saturday, February 8, 2014 from 12:00 – 4:00 P.M. and we are asking the City and the Mayor to declare that Albert Lexie Day and pull the whole community together. We have loads of toys that we thought Albert might enjoy handing out to the children in the community. He is an honorary member, life member of the Salvation Army Advisory Board and we would like to present him with a plaque. We have some divisional officers willing to come down and bring down the big brass band and make some noise and make a really nice day for Albert."

Mayor Mavrakis, "being that we won't have a Council meeting, I think that we can act on that right now. If we want to take a vote to have that special day for Albert, what is the Council's pleasure".
